Well, that's the end of Term 3 – where did it go?! Time has certainly flown but this is because we have been working hard and travelling to perform at the ABODA School Band Festival.

After a very successful Senior Camp earlier in the term, the Intermediate Band students participated in the ABODA Junior Band Festival. They worked really hard during the camp, completing over five hours of rehearsal on the Friday so that they were fully prepared for their performance on the Saturday. This rehearsing certainly paid off with the students doing an incredible job performing in the Churchlands SHS Concert Hall and received an award of "Excellent", which is a great outcome.

Congratulations need to be extended to their director, Mrs Danielle Parkinson, who has mentored these students throughout the year. Given that a lot of the older students either couldn't attend the festival or had moved up to Senior Band, this award is even more of a testament to the work that has been done in this ensemble. For many, this was their first festival and performing on a big stage.

Another first that happened this term was the first stand-alone Classical Guitar Workshop. Miss Fiona Lemon planned and implemented this workshop and performance that involved primary students from Vasse PS, Dunsborough PS and a student from West Busselton PS. Students rehearsed throughout the afternoon and performed a couple of pieces for parents and family members. The audience was very appreciative of the performance and the students did a great job and should all be pleased with their efforts. It will be great to see this event grow as the Classical Guitar programme develops.

As we look towards Term 4, the Year 12s will be graduation in the first couple of weeks and then for some, heading into ATAR exams. The Senior Band and Jazz will be performing at the BSHS Graduation in Week 2 and then we will farewell and celebrate the GBM Year 12s at our Senior Concert in Week 3. More information will be coming out at the beginning of next term so keep an eye on your emails so that you have all of the relevant information.

The lower school Students will have a very busy Term 4 with the Primary Workshop and Sundowner happening in Weeks 5 and 7 respectively. Again, this information will be coming out next term so stay tuned.

Students in Year 7 – 9 at Cape Nat, and Years 8 and 9 at BSHS will be completing subject selections for 2023 at the moment. It needs to be remembered that it is an IMSS requirement that all instrumental students must also enrol in Class Music for the year. The curriculum for Instrumental Music and Class Music are aligned and build upon the content from previous years. As such it is not possible to opt in and out of Class Music. The lower school programme will guide students toward the opportunity to enter upper school ATAR studies, which provides a pathway through to opportunities beyond high school. There is a lot of talent in the lower school years so it will be great to see these students continue through and fulfil their musical potential.

For now, though, enjoy the school holidays (but keep practising!) and we wish Miss Fiona Lemon all the best for her well-earned long service leave for Term 4. Mrs Joh Nordstrom will take on her brass teaching, with Miss Lemon returning the favour when Mrs Nordstrom heads off for first semester next year.
